ORDER DISMISSING PROCEEDING

The Florida Division of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) issued a Notice of Claim (NOC) against Vehoshua Vaknin (Respondent) charging it with one violation of the Federal Household Goods Regulations.² On or about November 27, 2013, the Field Administrator for FMCSA's Southern Service Center (Claimant) served a Request for Continuance and Docket Number.


