CEASE AND DESIST ORDER

This notice constitutes a Cease and Desist Order by the United States pursuant to 49 U.S.C. §§ 14701(a), 31133(10), 31144(c)(1) & (5) and pursuant to delegation of authority to the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA), United States Department of Transportation (USDOT). This Cease and Desist Order applies to Double Happiness Travel, Inc. USDOT # 1198260, MC # 477910, (DOUBLE HAPPYNESS) and its owners, officers and agents.

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY DOUBLE HAPPYNESS MUST CEASE ALL SALES OF INTERSTATE AND INTRASTATE MOTOR CARRIER TRANSPORTATION SERVICE, INCLUDING ALL SALES OF TICKETS OR VOUCHERS, WHETHER PERSONALLY OR THROUGH BROKERS, WEBSITES OR OTHER TRANSPORTATION INTERMEDIARIES, AND FURTHER MUST CEASE ALL SALES OF TRANSPORTATION SERVICE UNDER OTHER NAMES.

I. JURISDICTION

DOUBLE HAPPYNESS is a motor carrier of passengers and conducts or until recently conducted operations in interstate commerce pursuant to operating authority registration issued by FMCSA under 49 U.S.C. § 13902. DOUBLE HAPPYNESS transports passengers for compensation “between a place in ... a State and a place in another State” and is subject to FMCSA’s jurisdiction at 49 U.S.C. § 13501(1)(A).

II. BASIS FOR ORDER

On December 22, 2011, FMCSA completed a compliance review of DOUBLE HAPPYNESS's operations. The review uncovered numerous serious violations of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations. As a result of the extent and seriousness of the violations discovered by FMCSA, and the complete lack of safety management controls, FMCSA determined that DOUBLE HAPPYNESS's continued operations presented an imminent hazard to public safety. Accordingly, on December 23, 2011, FMCSA issued an Imminent Hazard Out-of-Service Order pursuant to 49 U.S.C. §§ 521(b)(5)(A) and 31144(c) and 49 C.F.R. § 386.72(b) directing DOUBLE HAPPYNESS to cease all commercial motor vehicle operations in interstate and intrastate commerce. See Imminent Hazard Order dated 12/23/2011, attached hereto and incorporated herein. Pursuant to 49 U.S.C. § 13905(f)(1)(B), FMCSA also revoked DOUBLE HAPPYNESS's operating authority registration on December 23, 2011.

The Imminent Hazard Order provides clear notice to DOUBLE HAPPYNESS of the steps and measures that it must take in order to resume motor carrier operations. These include applying for and receiving new operating authority registration following the company's submission and FMCSA's approval of evidence showing that DOUBLE HAPPYNESS has implemented all required steps to achieve and ensure continued compliance with FMCSA safety regulations. To date, DOUBLE HAPPYNESS has not complied with the required steps and measures.

FMCSA has learned that DOUBLE HAPPYNESS has been attempting to operate without operating authority registration and in violation of the Imminent Hazard Order. Such operations are unlawful. FMCSA has learned that tickets for DOUBLE HAPPYNESS are being advertised and sold on the Internet. FMCSA has also learned that DOUBLE HAPPYNESS is unlawfully

selling tickets for interstate transportation of passengers under operating authority registrations of other motor carriers. In order to compel compliance with 49 U.S.C. § 13901, FMCSA is ordering DOUBLE HAPPYNESS to cease and desist from providing tickets for sale of its transportation service under its name and/or the names of other motor carriers or through other motor carrier operations. Any such sales would result in a violation of 49 U.S.C. § 13901, and hence any such sales must cease immediately.

III. FAILURE TO COMPLY

Failure to comply with this Cease and Desist Order will subject DOUBLE HAPPYNESS to an action in United States District Court for equitable and/or declaratory relief.
