**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE
REGARDING SUSPENSION OF OPERATING AUTHORITY
REGISTRATION**

The United States Department of Transportation (USDOT), Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA), hereby orders Peace of Mind Relocation, Inc. to show cause why FMCSA should not suspend its operating authority registration.

By this Show Cause Order, FMCSA finds:

1. Peace of Mind Relocation, Inc. is a household goods motor carrier as defined in 49 U.S.C. § 13102(12), and has or has had operating authority registration issued pursuant to 49 U.S.C. § 13902 and 49 C.F.R. part 365.
2. By Final Agency Order served November 30, 2012, FMCSA determined that Peace of Mind Relocation, Inc. held hostage household goods of individual shippers in violation of Federal statute and regulations. Peace of Mind Relocation, Inc.'s refusal to give up possession of the shippers' household goods constituted a knowing and willful failure to give up possession of the household goods in violation of its estimate and contract after the shippers tendered payment.

Pursuant to 49 U.S.C. §§ 13905 and 14915(a)(3), FMCSA may suspend the operating authority registration of a motor carrier found holding household goods hostage. FMCSA may suspend motor carrier's operating authority registration for a period of not less than 12 months

nor more than 36 months. The force and effect of such suspension extends to and includes any carrier or broker having the same ownership or operational control as the suspended carrier.

If Peace of Mind Relocation, Inc. disputes the basis for this order and/or the findings herein, within thirty (30) calendar days of the service date of this Order, it must present evidence to demonstrate that its operating authority registration should not be suspended in accordance with 49 U.S.C. §§ 13905 and 14915(a)(3). Failure to present evidence within thirty (30) days of service of this order as described above will result in a Decision adopting as final the findings in this Order to Show Cause and suspending Peace of Mind Relocation, Inc.'s operating authority registration.
