

which the Defendants can be heard in opposition to Plaintiff's motion. Thus, the Court determines that immediate temporary relief is warranted under 49 U.S.C. § 507(c) and the equitable powers of this Court.

Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that Plaintiff's Motion for a Temporary Restraining Order is GRANTED. It is FURTHER ORDERED that:

1. Defendants are required to comply fully with the Imminent Hazard Out-of-Service Order and are enjoined from operating any commercial motor vehicle in and/or affecting interstate commerce until the Imminent Hazard Out-of-Service Order is rescinded by FMCSA.

2. Defendants are enjoined from (1) operating any commercial motor vehicle in and/or affecting interstate commerce that requires operating authority registration from FMCSA and (2) contracting or arranging to operate such commercial motor vehicles, unless and until Defendants obtain proper operating authority registration from FMCSA.

3. Defendants are enjoined from contracting or arranging with other motor carriers for transportation of passengers in and/or affecting interstate commerce unless the motor carrier(s) possesses valid and active operating authority registration from FMCSA.


4. Defendants are enjoined from applying for a new USDOT number and/or FMCSA operating authority registration under any other name or in the name of any other legal entity.

5. Any of Defendants' commercial motor vehicles that are in transit as of the date of this Court's order may proceed to the next scheduled stop where the vehicle's passengers can be safely transferred, but upon the vehicle's arrival, operation of the vehicle must cease in accordance with paragraphs 1 through 3 above.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that:

1. A Preliminary Injunction Hearing is scheduled for **Monday, March 26, 2012 at 2:00 p.m.** in Courtroom 17B, U.S. Courthouse, 601 Market Street, Philadelphia, PA.
2. Plaintiff's Counsel shall make personal service of this Temporary Restraining Order upon Defendants, and provide the Court with Proof of Service.
3. This Temporary Restraining Order shall expire on March 26, 2012.
