**CARRIER OPERATIONS OUT-OF-SERVICE ORDER FOR  
OPERATING BEYOND SCOPE OF REGISTRATION**

The Secretary of the United States Department of Transportation (the Secretary) has found that on October 1, 2012, the commercial motor vehicle operations of Derrick Jones dba Destiny Tours ("Destiny Tours") registered with the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration as an interstate transporter of passengers- not requiring authority. However, in the course of a compliance review conducted of Destiny Tours on February 19, 2013, FMCSA determined that Destiny Tours operated *for hire* in interstate commerce without the operating authority required by 49 USC§ 13901 on: May 21,2012, between Monroe, Michigan and Sandusky, Ohio; May 24,2012, between Taylor, Michigan and Sandusky, Ohio; January 21, 2013, between Toledo, Ohio and Washington, D.C.; and on February 3 and 8, 2013, between Toledo, Ohio and Auburn Hills, Michigan.

United States Code, title 49 section 13902(e)(1), as amended October I, 2012 by section 32111 of the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act ("MAP-21"; P.L. 112-141), and 49 CFR 392.9a authorize the Secretary to order out-of service the operations of a motor carrier for operating without a registration or beyond the scope of its operation. Accordingly, it is here by **ORDERED**, that Derrick Jones dba Destiny Tours is declared **OUT-OF SERVICE**

**EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY** and may not engage in interstate motor carrier operations.

Derrick Jones dba Destiny Tours may apply for operating authority registration as a motor carrier in accordance with the provisions of 49 CFR Part 365 by submitting form OP-1(P) to the FMCSA.

**RIGHT TO REVIEW**

You have the right to an administrative review in accordance with 5 U.S.C. § 554. If requested, administrative review shall occur within 10 calendar days of the issuance of this ORDER.
